We have very little history for the first 11 years of its life in which we believe it covered somewhere in the region of 77000 miles. Since then we have a comprehensive file with various works and MOT's and it has covered only 18000 miles in the last 44 years, one of the previous owners has listed all the old mot's and mileages covered in the year. The current owner has owned the car for the last 9 years, purchased from Arun Jaguar, and in that time he covered the grand total of 1762 Miles!!
